BA Business & Enterprise

Edinburgh Napier University in partnership with the academy of leadership & management is offering an innovative and flexible way of achieving your degree in one calendar year.

- A degree with many acceptable entry qualifications
- Flexible study pattern, one day per month at university (or local regional venue) with on-line support
- Opportunity to enter at three points in the year, January, May and September

Students who complete a range of vocational qualifications recognised by the Qualifications Credit Framework can now 'top up' to degree level by joining the BA Business and Enterprise.

The overall programme will provide:

- Workplace based learning, linked to organisational as well as personal objectives, designed to help you deliver business and personal results
- Learning and activities designed to help enhance the businesses in which you are working
- Development of enterprising people able to take forward the challenges of modern businesses or organisations

The BABE programme structure is very flexible and is built around the following modules:

- Innovation, Creativity and Enterprise (20 credits)

- Starting a New Business OR Business Processes (20 credits)
- Business Growth Issues (20 credits)
- A workplace-based learning project (60 credits)

You will attend Edinburgh Napier University once at the beginning of your course for Induction. Thereafter the one day per month contact will be delivered at local regional venues and is supported with on-line materials, and additional workshops for workplace based learning. This approach will minimise off-job time.

Your local regional venue will only run ONE of the Tri 2 modules locally. They will inform you which option they will be offering. You may instead choose the other module, just contact us and we will tell you where it is running. We will always run BOTH modules on campus in Edinburgh. This means for Tri 2 studies only you MAY have to travel an extra 2/3 days to ensure you get the module of your choice.

The aim of BA Business & Enterprise is to develop you and enhance your career opportunities. Assessments are therefore practical and applied, including reports around work roles, workplace-based assignments, presentations and case studies, BA Business & Enterprise has no traditional exams, we want you to apply your learning.

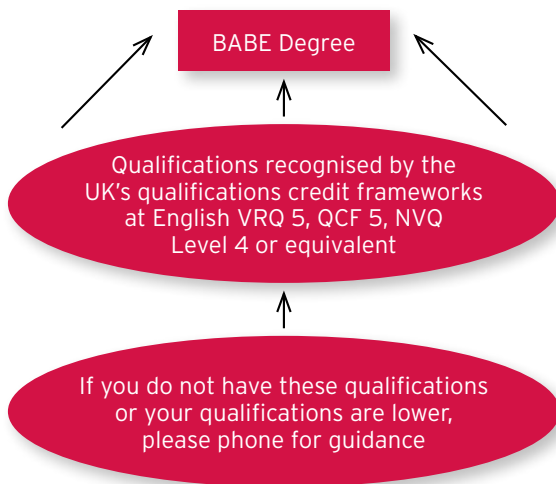
